EAST SIDE BUS STOP PARKING

The Board of Directors have received numerous complaints from homeowners who can't get in and out of Melody Ranch Dr. in the morning due to parents parking on both sides of Melody Ranch Dr. There is no parking along the west side of Melody Ranch Dr. near the entrance. If parents choose to drive their children to the bus stop, please drive to the Sage Meadows bus stop at the top of Palomino Dr. The bus comes 2 minutes earlier (7:39 am) and there are plenty of parking spots in the County Park and Ride lot. Another option is to have your children carpool with neighborhood kids. If the Board continues to receive complaints about the parking problems, violation letters will be sent to the individual homeowners.

CHRISTMAS TREE PICK UP SCHEDULE

VACANT LOT OWNERS PLEASE READ

Starting June 2012, Melody Ranch HOA will have Wyoming Landscape Company start spraying the 32 vacant lots for annual and noxious weeds. It will cost each vacant lot homeowner \$150 for 3 sprayings throughout the summer. The Board will give homeowners until May 30th, 2012 to opt out of this service. If a homeowner chooses to opt out, then the homeowner will need to send in a copy of a receipt showing their lot has been sprayed – and/or a commitment from them or a service provider to treat their vacant lots throughout the summer.

COVENANT CORNER From the Rules & Regulations

- All household and maintenance items such as wheel barrows, ladders, lawn mowers, snow blowers, bins etc.
 should not be left in open view and should be stored within a closed area such as a garage and/or behind fenced enclosure or "out of sight" from the road and neighboring properties view.
 Please see Article 5 - 5.6 in the CC&R's.
- Dogs are to be restrained / leashed within the community at all times. This includes while walking, running and bicycling on all roads and common areas within the community. Unrestrained dogs can lead to issues with wildlife and problems with other homeowners in the association. Please see Article 5 - 5.5 in the CC&R's.
