We have been receiving complaints about owners walking with their dogs and not watching where the dogs do their business. Please, if you are out with your dog, be aware and considerate of your neighbors. There are Mutt Mitt stations posted throughout Melody Ranch. Please make a habit out of cleaning up after your furry friend. A big shout out and thank you to those dog owners who have been proactive in clean up and roaming efforts - we sure do appreciate it!



COVENANT CORNER

~ Trash receptacles are to be placed at the edge of driveways only on the designated trash day. Once trash has been picked up, these receptacles must be removed from driveways within 24 hours. When not on the street for trash pick-up, all trash receptacles are to be stored in the garage or "out of sight" behind a fence enclosure. All trash must be kept in bins at all times. Bags of trash or other household items being disposed of are never to be left outside bins. Accumulation of garbage and/or building material or of the like constitutes a nuisance, and may be removed by the Association at the owner's expense. This is a tier one violation.

~Wildlife Protection. It is recognized by the Association and the purchasers or Owner of any Lot within the Property, that many wildlife species live on or migrate through the Property during various times of the year. Please respect seasonal limitations on use and do not harass the wildlife. This is a Tier Two, \$100 fine.

DID YOU KNOW?

In school we learned about the first Thanksgiving in 1621 when the Pilgrims celebrated for three days in Plymouth, Massachusetts with the Wampanoag Indians. Did you know that Sarah Joespha Hale, the author of "Mary Had a Little Lamb" is credited for the establishment of Thanksgiving as a national holiday. She lobbied five different presidents until one finally was agreeable to her idea. In 1863 Abraham Lincoln declared the last Thursday in November to be a national holiday to give thanks. Part of Mrs. Hale's contributions to the Thanksgiving holiday included recipes that she submitted via newspaper editorials. Many of today's traditional Thanksgiving dishes are contributed to her including turkey, stuffing, pumpkin pie, cranberry sauce, sweet potatoes and mashed potatoes. Nearly 91% of Americans eat turkey on Thanksgiving accounting to about 280 million turkeys being sold annually for this feast. Since 1947 the National Turkey Federation has presented a live turkey and two dressed turkeys to the President. The President does not eat the live turkey. He "pardons" it and allows it to live out its remaining days on an historical farm. May you all enjoy your Thanksgiving holiday with those who are near and dear to you.
