Of the 121 Melody Ranch homeowners who participated in the survey, 36% would like to see the board focus on improving the maintenance of our ponds and ditches. Design and install entry signs and re-purpose sales office each were ranked #1 by 17%, install playground equipment in Chickadee Circle was ranked #1 by 14%, and create play fields near Munger View Park was ranked #1 by 13%. We are thankful that 22 homeowners indicated they would be interesting in serving on a committee to help implement a well-designed, cost-effective and timely plan. We so appreciate the feedback and volunteers. Thanks for all the survey participation and helpful feedback. Holly Balogh was randomly selected as the winner of the one free month of dues for participating in the survey. The board is reviewing all of the additional comments and will decide the next steps at the upcoming board meetings throughout the fall.

COVENANT CORNER

- ~ All household and maintenance items such as wheel barrows, ladders, lawn mowers, snow blowers, bins etc. should not be left in open view and should be stored within a closed area such as a garage and/or behind fenced enclosure or "out of sight" from the road and neighboring properties view. This is Tier One Violation, \$25 fine
- ~ Unrestrained dogs can lead to issues with wildlife and problems with other homeowners in the association. In the event of issues with wildlife or children, dogs must be restrained at all times. This is Tier Three Violation, \$250 fine plus applicable legal fees.
