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TREE TRIMMING

Thank you to those homeowners that live at intersections and throughout Melody Ranch. Please keep in mind that the first 12-15' of your road front landscaping is in fact part of the road lot and the HOA/ISD may need to use that to improve road safety. If you planted trees or shrubbery along the roadway we have an obligation to make sure they do not overhang the roads or block driver visibility. From time to time, it may be necessary for those to be trimmed back to improve visibility on the roads. If you have been keeping up with this job your efforts are much appreciated. There may be an occasion when it is necessary for our landscaping crew to come in and be more aggressive in pruning. We will contact you if there is a problem and work with you to either perform the needed trimming yourself or have our landscape crew do it.

While the Valley prepares itself for the Total Eclipse on August 21st, please note that as a "non-essential" business, Grand Teton Property Management will be closed in compliance with request from Teton County and the Town of Jackson emergency management services. Our on-call services will be available 24-7 and we will respond to emergencies. We will be monitoring our emails to the best of our abilities that day but please be prepared that we may not be able to respond until the following day. This extraordinary moment marks the first total eclipse of the sun from all 48 contiguous United States since 1979. If you are able to view this phenomena, be sure to grab some eclipse glasses to protect your eyes as the moon moves in front of the sun covering it for several minutes. During this time the stars "come out", the horizon glows with a 360-degree sunset and you will feel night temperatures for several moments. No lands within the Subdivision shall ever be occupied or used by or for any structure or purpose or in any manner which is contrary to the Melody Ranch Final Development Plan as approved by the county Commissioners of Teton County, WY. This includes the provision of "**No Fireworks**". This is a Tier Four Violation, \$300 fine
