# **WEED SPRAYING**

If you own a vacant lot and would like to be responsible for spraying your noxious weeds this year, please notify Demerie at Grand Teton Property Management. If you opt to have the HOA do your spraying, the cost will be \$50 per application and it is done twice over the summer. If we do not hear from you by March 31 st, we will assume you want us to spray and you will see the charges on your monthly statement.

We recently had Mark Deluge from Teton County Weed and Pest speak at the board meeting. We learned at this meeting that all homeowners are welcome to participate in a cost-share program. If you sign up for this program, weed and pest will come to your home and show you what needs to be treated and how. They also have backpacks available to loan and has the correct spray on hand for you to purchase at a 50% discount. ## **COVENANT CORNER**

- ~ Holiday decorations including Christmas lights, wreaths and garland should be removed in a timely manner after the holiday has passed. Christmas lights shall be allowed from Thanksgiving Day until **February 15th**. This is a Tier One Violation, \$25 fine.
- ~ Trash receptacles are to be placed at the edge of driveways only on the designated trash day. Once trash has been picked up, these receptacles must be removed from driveways within 24 hours. When not on the street for trash pick-up, all trash receptacles are to be stored in the garage or "out of sight" behind a fence enclosure. All trash must be kept in bins at all times. Bags of trash or other household items being disposed of are never to be left outside bins. Accumulation of garbage and/or building material or of the like constitutes a nuisance, and may be removed by the Association at the owner's expense. This is Tier One Violation, \$25 fine

## **DID YOU KNOW?**

February is from the Latin term februum which means purification. In Finnish, the month is called helmikuu which translates as "month of the pearl" named after the appearance of when snow melts on tree branches forming droplets which then freeze again like a pearl of ice.
