Our Ice Rínk Rules...

- 1. The ice rink is for the <u>private</u> use of Melody Ranch residents and their guests.
- 2. <u>No rough play</u> allowed on the rink.
- Please <u>be aware</u> and use caution when skating on the rink. Be aware of your skating ability and the ability of other skaters around you.
- 4. <u>Be considerate</u> to other rink users. Please allow everyone equal time on the rink.
- 5. Please limit your time to a maximum of $\underline{1}$ <u>hour</u> when others are waiting.
- 6. You are <u>responsible</u> for clearing snow from the rink prior to use, and resurfacing the ice as needed.
