BUS STOP PARKING MELODY RANCH DR.

A safety issue has again been brought to the Board's attention on Melody Ranch Drive. Parents are driving their kids to the school bus stop and parking while they wait for the bus. This creates an unsafe condition near the bus stop. Children tend to run around and play while waiting for the bus and with the number of cars parked in the vicinity, cars traveling through may not see a child running out into the street until it is too late. Also, with parents parking on both sides of the street, it effectively becomes a single lane road. Traffic accidents could occur or emergency vehicles may not quickly get through.

In addition to the safety issues, cars being parked on the side of the road have damaged or destroyed the grass and the sprinkler heads. Repairs are costly and we all pay for them with our HOA dues.

Please do not park on the grass or the roadway when dropping your child off at the school bus stop. Either drop them off and leave or walk them to the bus stop. An alternate is for parents to use the County Park and Ride lot at the east end of Palomino Drive at the intersection with Sage Meadows Road. This is an official school pick up school bus stop. It has adequate and safe parking if you must wait for your child to load onto the school bus.

SALES OFFICE

Progress is being made! The Teton County Parks and Recreation department is still on track to have the Munger View playground equipment installed this October.

The HOA Board and the Parks Committee members have reviewed an initial draft master plan layout for the Sales office area to eventually include the amenities that our homeowners were most excited about. The draft plan calls for a phase in approach to the space development. Phase 1 involves two great additions possibly for this winter: an X-Country and Skate Ski loop, and a nice sized ice rink.

We are pricing the two items and may be able to fund the ski track plowing through the HOA operating budget without any increase in dues. For the Ice Rink, we are requesting the support of our community. The Ice Rink will need funding, so we are setting up a Special Project with the Community Foundation. This will enable us to take taxdeductible donations and other funding opportunities through a tax exempt account. Please be on the lookout for more information about the Special Project funding. For the Ice Rink, we will also need the help of volunteers to help build the forms for the rink, flood it, and remove it in the spring. Users will need to clear the snow and "resurface" the ice as needed throughout the winter. Please see the rink structures we are considering at www.nicerink.com. Second phase of the project involves determining the usability of the sales office and possibly adding a sled hill, 1/2 court basketball area, picnic tables and swings. This phase of the project will be considered next spring.
