BUDGET HEARING

The Melody Ranch ISD will be having the annual budget hearing on Tuesday, June 22, 2021 at 5:30pm. This meeting will be held via zoom and will allow the ISD to review the upcoming budget for the 2021-2022 fiscal year.

[~]The Melody ISD is proposing an increase in water usage fees of approximately 13%, from \$1.50 each 1000 gallons used to \$1.70 each 1000 gallons used. The 2021-2022 fiscal budget reflects this increase. [~]There is no proposed increase in property taxes. This meeting is open to the public. COVENANT CORNER

~ Trailers, boats, RV's, and inoperable vehicles of any kind are not permitted to be parked in driveways, in yards or on the street at any time. These may be stored on properties as so that they are never visible by neighboring properties, i.e.: in garages. This is Tier Two Violation, \$100 fine.

~ No buildings, structures, or improvements of any nature shall be placed, erected altered, or permitted to remain on any recreational open space area. This includes but not limited to the following: fencing (real or invisible), private landscaping (except with ARC prior approval), trampolines, storage sheds, etc. This is a Tier Three Violation, \$250 fine.
