2022-2023 ISD ANNUAL BUDGET HEARING

Notice is hereby given that the Melody Ranch Improvement and Service District hearing on the proposed budget for the Melody Ranch Improvement and Service District, for the 2022-2023 fiscal year ending June 30, 2023, which is now being considered by the Directors of the District, will be held on June 29, 2022, via Zoom. The budget hearing will commence at 5:30 p.m.

This proposed budget for 2022-2023 has an increase in water rates. The District Board has proposed to implement a tiered water billing system. This billing system will work as follows; a monthly \$5.00 Base Fee, plus a monthly usage fee for 0 to 60,000 gallons of water billed at \$2.10 per 1000 gallons and 60,001 gallons and above will be billed out at \$3.00 per 1000 gallons. There will be no increase in property taxes. The projected income is \$294,226 and the projected expenses total \$294,226.

COVENANT CORNER

~ Trailers, boats, RV's, and inoperable vehicles of any kind are not permitted to be parked in driveways, in yards or on the street at any time. These may be stored on properties as so that they are never visible by neighboring properties, i.e.: in garages. This is Tier Two Violation, \$100 fine.

~ No buildings, structures, or improvements of any nature shall be placed, erected altered, or permitted to remain on any recreational open space area. This includes but not limited to the following: fencing (real or invisible), private landscaping (except with ARC prior approval), trampolines, storage sheds, etc. This is a Tier Three Violation, \$250 fine.
